RE: Provider Expiration Dates

The New York State Department of Health Bureau of EMS and Trauma Systems (BEMSAT) has extended **ALL** provider expiration dates for their NYS EMT Certifications due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This includes CFR, EMT, AEMT, Critical Care and Paramedic providers.

- BEMSAT will not be able to send new cards to all providers across the state prior to many of your expiration dates. This extension also includes any providers who expired between September 1st, 2019 and today.
- A printed copy or PDF from the Health Commerce System (HCS) will serve as proof of your expiration date.
- Certified Lab Instructors and Coordinators will also be extended.
- We do not have access to CLI and CIC extension dates, if you are going to expire soon, please contact Elizabeth Donnelly at the BEMSAT through your course sponsor administrator.

Directions:

- All EMS Services regardless of level (BLSFR, Transport, ALS FR) are allowed access to the HCS.
- Some EMS Services already have representatives assigned in the HCS (see attachment).
- If you would like to have a representative and an alternate placed on the Health Commerce System (<https://commerce.health.state.ny.us/>), we will need the following:
 - Follow the steps outlined in "A. User Steps" on page 2 of this document. After completing Step 7 on page 2, scan and send the documents to mlrems@mlrems.org as we are your HCS Coordinators.
 - Upon receipt of the email, we will complete your registration and verify your account (will need a copy of your photo ID).
 - If your name does not match what is on your photo ID, we can't register you.
 - Without your registration ID, we can't register you.

Please note that due to the sheer number of EMS providers in the Monroe-Livingston Regional EMS system, the Program Agency cannot complete individual EMT expiration verifications. As such, we've created step by step instructions (page 3-4 of this document) that walks you through how to look up your individual providers.

If you need to reset your password, first try to use the [forgot password link](#) located on the [HCS homepage](#). If you are unsuccessful in resetting your password, you will need to contact the Commerce Accounts Management Unit: 1-866-529-1890 option 1. Be sure to have your NYS driver license or NYS non-driver photo ID on hand prior to calling.

Paperless HCS User Account

NEW! Paperless HCS User Accounts for non medical professionals OR all those needing access to UAS. The Health Commerce System (HCS) user account request has gone paperless! No more signatures and notary are needed. Applying for an HCS user account is as simple as filling out an online form and having a valid Photo ID, such as a NYS DMV Driver's License, NYS DMV Non-driver Photo ID, Passport, etc. People that do not have a valid Photo ID can still apply for an HCS user account using the existing process which requires signatures and a notary. Please see your HCS Coordinator to apply.*

A. User steps...

What are the steps?

To obtain an account, you must:

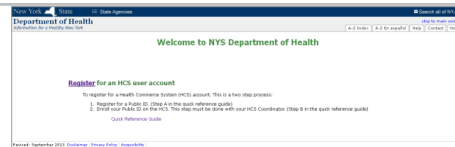
1. Register for an account
2. Enroll your account on the HCS. This step must be done with your HCS Coordinator

Where do I register?

1. Open your web browser and enter this website in the address bar

<https://apps.health.ny.gov/pub/usertop.html>

2. Click '**Register**' for an account'



How do I register?

1. Complete the Name, Address and Policy Statement sections, and click **Continue**
NOTE: Your name must match what is on your Photo ID
2. Create a user ID and password, click **Continue**
3. Answer at least six of the 27 secret questions, click **Register**
4. Confirm your account information, and click **Confirm**
5. Print your NYSDOH Account Registration Completion information, click **OK**
6. Print your confirmation email that your user ID was created
7. See your *HCS Coordinator with your NYSDOH Account Registration Completion email printout, and your Photo ID

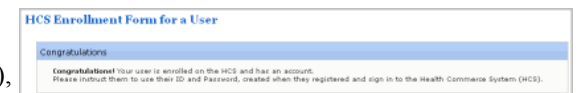
How do I enroll a user with the paperless process?

1. Log on the HCS
2. Click **Coord Account Tools -HCS** under My Applications
* Counties click Coord Account Tools—LHD
3. Click **User** under 'Request an account for a...'
4. Select **Yes, they have a Valid Photo ID**

Does the user have a Valid Photo ID, such as a NYS DMV Driver's License, NYS DMV Non-driver Photo ID, Passport, etc.

- **Yes, they have a Valid Photo ID**
This process requires their name to match their Photo ID exactly. If it does not match, you may click "No they do not have... link, even if they have Valid Photo ID, to fill out the hardcopy form for an account.

- **No, they do not have a valid Photo ID**
This process is by hardcopy and can take up to seven business days to obtain an HCS account.

5. Select your organization from the list
6. Enter the user's HCS ID, click **Submit**
NOTE: This information must be supplied by the user when they registered for an HCS account
7. Enter the user's information from the Photo ID, click **Submit**
NOTE: The information must match exactly
8. Enter the user's contact information (fields marked with an asterisk are required), click **Submit**
9. Your user is enrolled on the HCS. Please instruct them to use their user ID and password they created and sign in the HCS (<https://commerce.health.state.ny.us>)



C. User steps...

How do I sign on the HCS?

Once your HCS Coordinator completes their steps above, you will be enrolled on the HCS, and receive a congratulations email. Do the following:

1. Read the 'Document 2 SAUP' for rules and responsibilities
2. Click the HCS website link (or copy and paste it in your browsers address bar), and enter your user ID and password that you created when registering
