At the May 18th meeting of the Monroe-Livingston EMS Council, the [CME Allocation Matrix for Original Standardized Course Offerings](#) was approved.

This Allocation Matrix applies ONLY to ORIGINAL courses. CIC's may permit CME credits for recertification courses at their discretion and consistent with NYS DOH CME Recertification Program Guidance.

The purpose of the Allocation Matrix is to provide guidance and consistency to NYS CIC's that manage CME-based recertification programs in our region. As such, the information contained in the document is a recommendation, not a regional mandate, and the CIC has ultimate responsibility for allocating CME credits for coursework.
